Much of what you'll taste begins ashore, where our chefs shop the local markets in port and bring regional ingredients aboard.

Elsewhere across the yacht, each specialty restaurant has a character of its own. Basil + Bamboo brings Mediterranean and Asian flavors together in unexpected ways. Star Grill fires up on the open deck for barbecue and carved-to-order meats. At Veranda, breakfast and lunch are served buffet-style or à la carte, with tables indoors or al fresco beneath the awning. And Candles, our specialty steakhouse, pairs prime cuts and fresh seafood with classic sides in an intimate, candlelit setting.

Wherever you sit down, the meal is always included — even in your stateroom, with room service available 24 hours a day.

OVERNIGHT STAYS AND SEASONAL DISCOVERIES

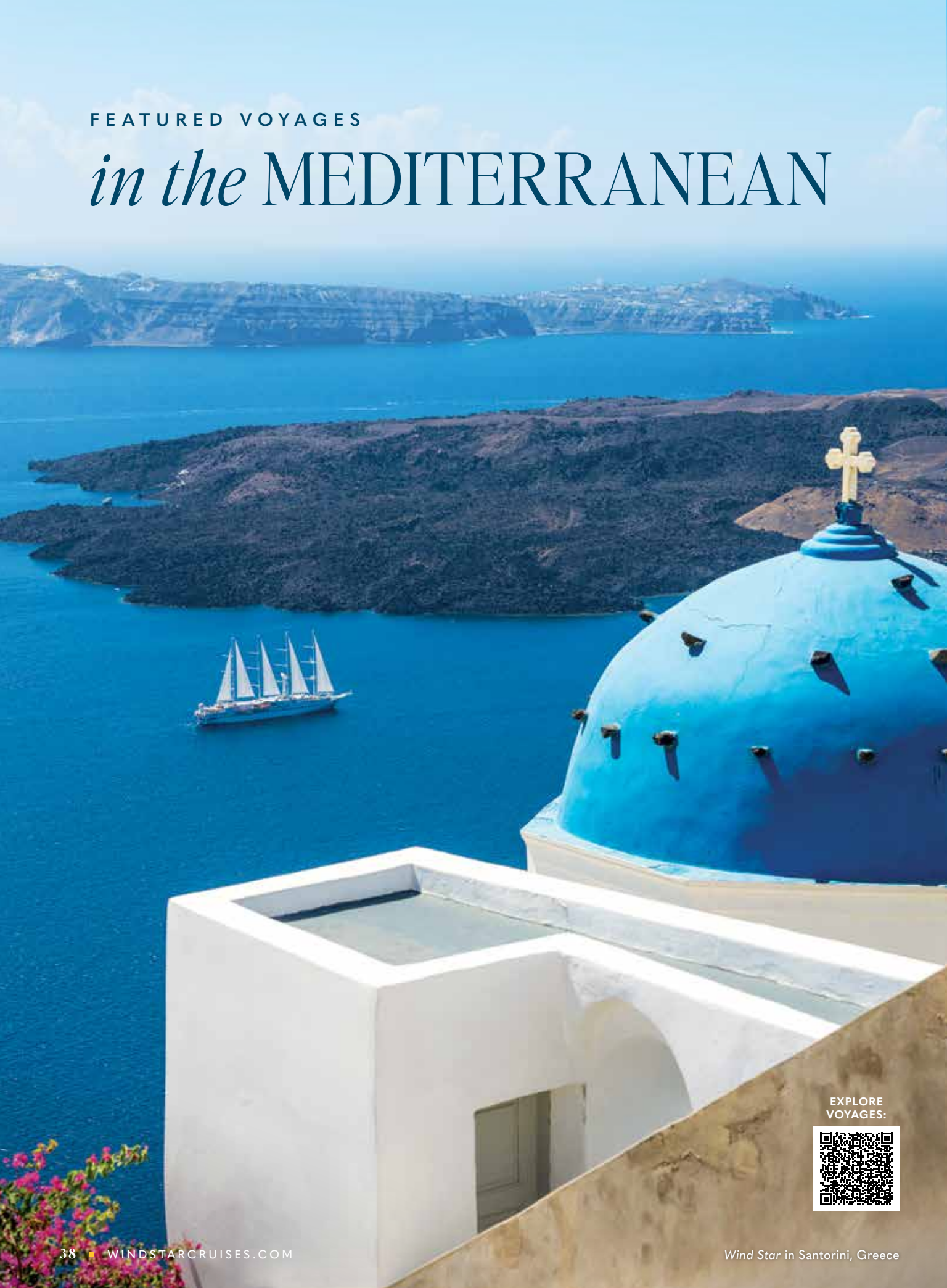

Dock steps from St. Mark's Square for an overnight in the Venice lagoon — closed to most ships. Learn to cook pizza in a Sicilian kitchen, wake up in the shadow of Vesuvius and walk Dubrovnik's walls at golden hour.

Inside & Out

Few regions Windstar sails compress this much variety into a single season. Start in April among the Dutch canal-ring cities and Belgian chocolate towns — Amsterdam, Harlingen, Bruges and an overnight in Antwerp — and by June your all-suite yacht is cruising Norway's Geirangerfjord at eye level, waterfalls dropping from sheer walls into water that runs deep beside villages of a few hundred.

Elsewhere, Northern Europe takes on entirely different dimensions. In the Baltic, the yacht threads Stockholm's archipelago on the way to an overnight in the heart of the city. Farther out, a circumnavigation of Iceland brings you to Heimaey's 1973 lava fields before reaching Seydisfjardur, where local musicians bring Icelandic folk songs into the town's Blue Church. Along Europe's Atlantic edge, your yacht sails up the Thames beneath Tower Bridge to tie up in the heart of London. Then the mood turns toward wine and river: the Seine winds inland past mansions and rolling hills to Rouen; Bordeaux opens onto the left- and right-bank vineyards.

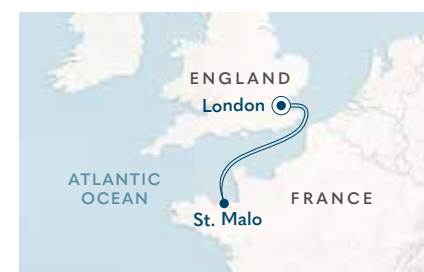

Circumnavigate Iceland under the Midnight Sun. Explore a lava cave, soak in hot springs steaming at the edge of the sea and overnight in Seydisfjörður, a village of colorful chalets tucked into the eastern coast.

Amber glows in Gdansk's market stalls. Tallinn and Riga still keep their medieval streets pedestrian-only. And in the Stockholm Archipelago, the painted holiday homes drift past your window at dusk.

Recess in the Yachtsman's Playground

Sail the Lesser Antilles and you move between French, Dutch and British influences in just a few days. Dominica's rainforest peaks give way to the arid ABC Islands — flamingos on the salt pans, cactus on the hills — then flatten into the low coral cays of the Virgin Islands.

A Windstar yacht is small enough to anchor off tiny Bequia in the Grenadines and dock in the heart of Old San Juan, bringing remarkably different worlds within a single week: croissants and Ti Punch on French St. Barts; morning coffee beneath the pastel Dutch gables of Willemstad; a night at anchor off Nevis, its volcanic silhouette dark against the stars. Even the water isn't one color, turquoise glass in the Grenadines, cobalt off the Windwards' volcanic drop-offs, warm pale shallows along Anguilla.

It's the Caribbean escape you imagined, with far more to discover along the way.

JOST VAN DYKE

Ask any yachtsman about Jost Van Dyke and watch their face light up. Known as the Barefoot Island, it has fewer than 300 residents. We'll anchor right in Great Harbour, the "commercial hub," giving you more time in port once most visitors are back in Tortola.

ST. BARTHÉLEMY

St. Barts fits an entire French-Caribbean sensibility into 8 square miles — gingerbread cottages above Gustavia's harbor, designer boutiques along the waterfront, white sand just beyond. Order a Ti Punch and watch the kite surfers fly.

VIRGIN GORDA

There's something geological, almost sculptural, about Virgin Gorda. Wander through the Baths, a collection of massive boulders that form a labyrinth of grottoes along the shore, then climb Gorda Peak for panoramic views of the island chain.

CONCIERGE COLLECTION: CARIBBEAN COOKING AND FOLKLORE Basseterre, St. Kitts and Nevis

Over the course of an afternoon, your guide prepares regional dishes while sharing how African, European and Indian traditions blended together on these islands. Sample everything with homemade refreshments and take the recipes home with you.

SUNSET CRUISE Gustavia, St. Barthélemy

The sun sits low over the harbor as you push off on a sailing catamaran, the masts of anchored yachts catching the last gold light. Refreshments and light snacks come around as you cross.

CONCIERGE COLLECTION: DEEP SEA FISHING Charlestown, St. Kitts and Nevis

Hop on board a fully equipped fishing vessel as its captain takes you to prime fishing grounds. Feel the thrill of the “screaming lines” or learn the local methods for catching a variety of sport fish. The boat’s captain will be there to lend a helping hand.

WHALE AND DOLPHIN ADVENTURE Roseau, Dominica

Cruise along the west coast of Dominica, the Nature Island, in search of wildlife. This is a calving area for whales, so sightings are likely. Periodically drop the hydrophones to listen for each species’ distinctive sounds, from humpback songs to whistling dolphins.

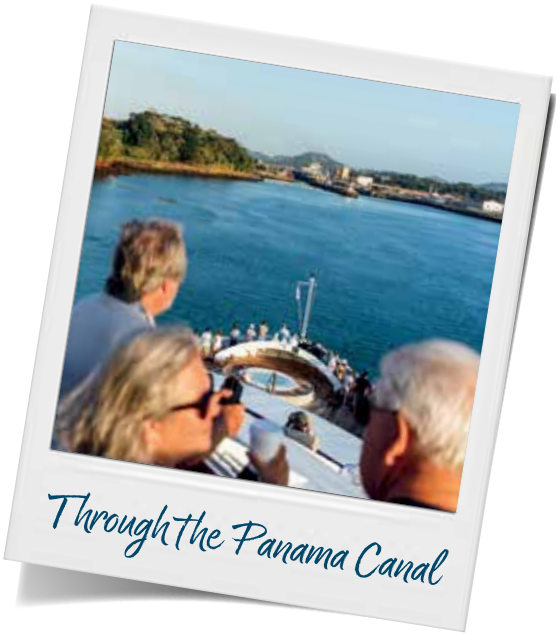

Part of Chiriquí Marine National Park, Isla Parida sits within a protected archipelago of 50 islands, with white-sand beaches and clear waters that stay around 82 degrees year-round. This escape is yours to enjoy during Windstar's Signature Beach Party, complete with a delicious tropical feast.

Sandwiched between the coast and Corcovado National Park, "Port Jim" is our gateway to one of Costa Rica's most untouched and biodiverse areas. There's no pier here, so your RIB boat takes you straight to shore for a wet landing: a step into shallow water, then onto a sandy beach where jungle-covered hills rise behind you and monkeys call from the trees.

Make a wet landing on this stunning crescent of white sand on Costa Rica's Gold Coast. Snorkel with some of the most colorful tropical fish in the Pacific, hike to a scenic waterfall in Rincon de la Vieja National Park or ride horseback across the savanna in the tradition of Costa Rica's *sabaneros*.

Follow your naturalist guide through the rainforest, listening to birds and watching for toucans, hummingbirds, monkeys and other forest residents. Visit a private museum to learn how coffee is grown and produced, then enjoy a hearty traditional Costa Rican lunch.

CONCIERGE COLLECTION: CHIRIQUI GULF FISHING TOUR Isla Parida, Panama

The inshore waters around the Isla Parida archipelago are home to more than 20 species of game fish. Cast, troll or jig for jacks, mackerel, big cubera snapper, snook and the famous roosterfish, one of the most sought-after species for many saltwater anglers.

Visit a traditional plantation growing cacao, a tropical crop whose history stretches back to the Mayas. Taste fresh fruit from the "chocolate tree," learn the steps of making good chocolate and enjoy a chocolate fondue with fresh fruit and banana bread.

COSTA RICAN COWBOY EXPERIENCE Playa Flamingo, Costa Rica

Step into the boots of a Costa Rican *sabanero* for the day. Ride out through Guanacaste's countryside, watching for armadillos and anteaters along the way, then help round cattle into the paddocks. Back at the hacienda, swap stories over traditional bites that have fueled working cowboys here for generations.

GUNA YALA

Guardians of the Gilded Coast

Sailing the aquamarine waters of the San Blas archipelago, the postcard view is immediate. But the real story here is the people who call it home. For centuries, the Guna have sustained this stretch of Caribbean coast on their own terms, preserving their language, their dress and a way of life that is distinctly their own.

THE FABRIC OF IDENTITY

Guna culture comes vividly into view in the *mola*, a hand-sewn textile panel incorporated into a traditional blouse, with layered designs of sea turtles, birds and images drawn from Guna life and belief. More than clothing, they're a visual language, with each line carrying meaning drawn from nature.

FOR THE GREATER GOOD

What sets the Guna apart isn't only what they've protected, but how. The General Congress, made up of representatives from Guna communities, governs Guna Yala under its own laws. Outside land ownership is forbidden and tourism is tightly controlled.

A matrilineal social structure places women at the center of cultural and family life. Visit a village and you're entering a place that has worked, deliberately and at every turn, to determine its own future.

Across these hundreds of islands, the Guna remain the authors of what comes next. They welcome visitors on their terms, into a Caribbean shaped not by resort developers, but by the people whose home it has long been.

Past the Trailhead, *Into the Cloud*

Latin America's biodiversity has its rightful headliners — the mist of Monteverde's cloud forest, the geothermal slopes of Arenal, the canopy of Manuel Antonio National Park — and then it has the wilder, less-visited corners that most cruise itineraries never reach. Windstar takes you to both.

Imagine spotting spider monkeys or brilliant scarlet macaws in Curu National Wildlife Refuge, a rare glimpse into a rewilding success story.

Or finding three-toed sloths camouflaged in the lush canopy of Manuel Antonio National Park, and coral gardens teeming with tropical fish in Bocas del Toro. We make these remote wonders effortlessly accessible.

With a small-enough yacht and a route designed around them, you get to witness these ecosystems firsthand. And that, after all, is one of the reasons travelers are drawn to Latin America in the first place.

Sailing Tahiti with Windstar, you don't just visit the islands — you wake somewhere new most mornings, and the culture sails with you in between.

WE BRING TAHITI ON BOARD

Polynesian traditions come aboard before you step ashore. Polynesian Cultural Ambassadors sail the full voyage with you — teaching *pareo*-tying on deck, sharing the history of the ancient *marae* (sacred sites) and playing ukulele at sunset. On some sailings, specialists like Tihoti, a Polynesian tattoo master and musician, join to share stories no guidebook tells. In Bora Bora, our Polynesian Feast & Fire on a private *motu* pairs traditional Tahitian dance with a fire-dancing finale that lights up the night.

ASHORE, AMONG LOCALS

Slip between *motus* by traditional outrigger canoe, the same craft that carried the Pacific's first navigators across thousands of miles of open ocean. On Raiatea, local guides walk you through Taputapuatea, the UNESCO *marae* where Polynesian chiefs and navigators once gathered from across the Pacific. On Fatu Hiva in the Marquesas, local artists share the time-honored craft of *tapa*, transforming bark into intricately decorated cloth.

SOCIETY ISLANDS

The Society Islands are the French Polynesia most people picture — and with good reason. Bora Bora's Mount Otemanu rises straight from a lagoon that shifts from pale turquoise to deep sapphire by the hour.

Beyond Bora Bora, Huahine's 400-year-old stone fish traps remain in daily use, while the vanilla plantations of Taha'a perfume the air. On Raiatea, Pacific navigators once gathered at Taputapuātea marae — a UNESCO site you can still walk today.

MARQUESAS

In a part of the world defined by water, the Marquesas pull you inland. Volcanic cliffs drop straight into the Pacific, and the islands rise into misty spires, hidden waterfalls and valleys where stone tikis still stand under banyan trees.

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Marquesas are home to a rare concentration of living Polynesian culture — petroglyphs, ancient *marae* and *tapa* cloth still pounded from mulberry bark. Windstar is one of the few cruise lines that calls here.

TUAMOTUS

If the Marquesas are vertical, the Tuamotus are horizontal — the world's largest chain of coral atolls, where narrow ribbons of sand barely rise above the tide.

Rangiroa's lagoon alone could hold all of Tahiti, and pearl farms grow black pearls on lines suspended beneath its surface. At Fakarava, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, snorkelers drift through corridors of gray reef sharks, manta rays and walls of parrotfish without lifting a fin.

Board a skiff for a short ride to the over-the-water reef house and pearl farm just beside the coral barrier reef. Watch pearl grafters at work, and swim over the oyster beds and through the coral garden to find your own personal oyster and black pearl.

SNORKEL SAFARI & STINGRAY ENCOUNTER Bora Bora, French Polynesia

Glide across the lagoon until the captain drops anchor on a shallow sandbank, where your guide will show you how to interact with the graceful stingrays that swim around you. Then snorkel in a coral garden, watching for butterfly fish, groupers and other rainbow-colored species.

Set out across Fakarava's vast lagoon, passing uninhabited motus ringed in coconut palms. Anchor over the shallows to snorkel directly from the boat, spotting tropical fish and harmless black-tipped reef sharks. Between stops, watch seabirds coast overhead across this UNESCO Biosphere Reserve.

Ride by ATV into Moorea's interior, climbing to Belvedere Lookout as Cook Bay and Opunohu Bay open below, divided by the jagged peak of Mount Rotui. Follow the pineapple trail, pausing at a small river to spot eels before a juice tasting at the Rotui factory.
